When conditions are conducive to rapid disease development, Sonata must be used in a tank mix program with other registered products, such as spray oil or copper- based fungicides, at labeled rates.</p> <p>Post bloom fruit drop – For suppression, begin applications at early bloom and when conditions are conducive to disease development. Repeat on 7 to 14 day intervals or as needed. Utilize the shorter spray interval between applications if warm, wet conditions persist.</p> <p>Citrus scab – For suppression, begin applications at first new foliar flush and repeat at petal fall and at ½ inch diameter fruit.</p> <p>Melanose – For suppression, begin applications at petal fall and repeat on 7 to 14 day intervals until fruit becomes resistant.</p> <p>Alternaria Leaf Spot - Begin applications when environmental conditions and plant stage are conducive to disease development. Repeat on 7 to 14 day intervals or as needed.</p> <p>For improved performance on post bloom fruit drop, scab and melanose, use Sonata in a tank mix or rotational program with other registered fungicides.</p>
